

# MCHS Reopening Guidelines



In-person Instruction will occur Monday through Thursday, with Friday instruction being online.

Online Option (NTI) will utilize the Canvas educational platform. Videos, live chats and live classes will be available. Students may request in-person face-to-face meetings or conferences with teachers as needed.

<b>Before School</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Self Screening at home</li><li>• If temperature is 100.4 or higher, student will need to stay home</li><li>• All students will be wanded prior to entering the building</li></ul>
<b>Transportation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Temperature will be taken prior to boarding bus</li><li>• Masks must be worn</li><li>• Assigned seats to aid with contact tracing</li></ul>
<b>Arrival</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Assigned entrances will be utilized for car-riders, drivers and bus riders.</li><li>• Doors will open at 7:10 am.</li><li>• Temperature checks and screening will be done at entry for all students and staff.</li><li>• Car-riders will have temperatures taken before exiting the vehicle.</li><li>• Masks must be worn.</li><li>• Students will report directly to their 1st period teacher.</li></ul>
<b>Breakfast</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Breakfast will be served in classrooms just before 1st period.</li><li>• Grab-n-go breakfast will <u>not</u> be</li></ul>

	offered later in the morning.
<b>Classroom Instruction and Class Changes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Class periods will be reduced to 3 periods a day due to contact tracing expectations from the CDC.</li><li>• Students <u>will</u> get to take elective, dual credit and career pathway courses.</li><li>• Masks must be worn when 6-foot distancing is not possible, or when moving.</li><li>• Desks/surfaces will be cleaned between groups of students during class changes.</li><li>• There will be hallway restrictions (one way, no stopping, vending machines closed)</li><li>• Frequent handwashing and sanitation breaks will be incorporated into classroom routines.</li><li>• While water fountains will not be available, water will be provided to students.</li><li>• Lockers will not be used. Drawstring bags are permitted.</li><li>• Bathroom breaks will be scheduled during class time instead of during transitions between class.</li></ul>
<b>Lunch</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Lunch will be in the gym adhering to the social distancing guidelines.</li><li>• No off-campus lunch.</li><li>• Students may bring their own lunch.</li></ul>

<p><b>Extra-Curricular</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• No field trips or assemblies will be planned until allowed by health guidelines.</li><li>• Sports will follow KHSAA guidelines.</li><li>• Music programs will follow KMEA recommendations.</li><li>• Club meetings will be offered in a virtual format after school hours.</li></ul>
<p><b>Dismissal</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Car-riders and drivers will be dismissed in sections with staggered dismissal times, reducing the number in the hallway.</li><li>• Bus riders will be dismissed in sections with staggered dismissal times.</li></ul>
<p><b>Distance Learning (NTI)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Teachers will lead instruction with the same curriculum under both models.</li><li>• Student learning and content mastery are expected of ALL students.</li><li>• Canvas educational platform will be utilized for online learning.</li><li>• Extracurricular activities are available to students under both models.</li></ul>
